Subject : Action to liquidate the pending recoveries in ESIC

Sir,

It is informed that the Standing Committee and Corporation time and again has shown concern on the pending recoveries with the different field offices of the ESIC and directed that all efforts should be made to liquidate the pending recoveries utilising all the measures available.

In this context instructions have been issued vide letter nos. Q-11/24/Audit/2006/RRC dated 04/07/2025, 11/24/MPR/2022/RRC dated 18/08/2025 and 11/24/MPR/2022/RRC dated 09/09/2025. From review of the data received from the field offices, it has been observed that the recovery has not been achieved the pace vis-à-vis the targets fixed for the respected regions and till July only 12% of the provisional target has been achieved.

Further considering the pending amount in the following heads considerable amount has been shown by the regions as non-recoverable :

Amount in liquidation	: Rs. 667.25 crore
Amount with claim commissioner	: Rs. Rs. 17.10 crore
Decree obtained but no execution	: Rs. 1.79 crore
Declared sick and rehabilitation scheme sanction	: Rs. 84.03 crore


All Regional Directions/SRO Incharges are requested to kindly advise the Recovery Officers to review all above cases as it may be possible that in some of the cases the recovery might have been received, or the amount might have become irrecoverable.

In addition to above, all efforts should be made to recover the outstanding recoveries by exploring all the methods available under the existing provisions including attachment of the properties of defaulting units/employers.

An action taken report in this regard may be given by 15th October'2025.


